Quick Notes and Tips for Transportation to School

Bus Riders

- Treat the bus as an extension of the classroom.
 - Follow the directions of the driver.
 - Remain in your seat.
 - Treat others with respect.
- Locate your pick-up time and location through Home Access.
 - Practice walking to your bus stop.
 - Arrive 5 minutes early to your bus stop.

Walkers

- Identify a safe walking path and practice it prior to the start of school.
- Use marked crosswalks.
- Walk in groups.

Bicycles

- Identify a safe biking path and practice it prior to the start of school.
- Bike to school in a group.
- Wear protective gear like helmets, elbow pads, and bright clothing or a vest.
- Walk bikes when on school property.

Drop-off Line

- Review Hill's drop-off and pick-up procedures.
- Be aware of local traffic caused by construction, inclement weather, or nearby schools.
- Follow the directions of Hill staff members present to help keep students safe and traffic flowing.
